Nebo Goal Connection: Elementary Reading

- *3rd grade students' reading proficiency will continue to exceed the current state standard and improve annually at the school level according to the DIBELS assessment.*

DISCUSSION:

  - Discussed how another benchmark day was added in January. Funds from trust lands were used to pay substitutes for that day.
  - We talked about how teachers do at least one running record each day.
  - Talked about our literacy collaboration and what that looks like.
  - We discussed the action plan from last year.

  - Next time we want to look at making any changes on goal number 1, and look at the budget and see if we want to make any changes there.

She also brought up how computers are used in school, and how important it is to make sure that students are not exposed to things that may not be educational. We want to use computers for essential things.
