

# Art City Elementary School Community Council Meeting Minutes

January 18, 2018

3:15 p.m.

1. Approved minutes from previous meeting: The minutes from our last meeting were approved and seconded.
2. Talked about goal number 1. We want them to increase 3 percent from beginning of the year to end of year. Measuring the 3rd grade in DIBELS.
3. Goal #1: The percent of students in grades 1-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress will improve from 70% to 73%.

Nebo Goal Connection: Elementary Reading

- *3rd grade students' reading proficiency will continue to exceed the current state standard and improve annually at the school level according to the DIBELS assessment.*

4. Discussed using some money from trustlands for hiring technicians to cover recess duty for teachers. There was some concern about bullying and technicians not knowing the students and not being able to handle or see bullying problems. We also discussed our Stand Strong program and how it is helping us with issues during recess. We have now added that to school website. The principal will also put it in her Monday message.
5. Discussed using some of the Trustlands money to pay for substitutes for teachers to meet 3 times a year for a half a day to discuss data and make goals for students in a Data Dive meeting.
6. Discussed Goal #2 (The number of integrated fine arts lessons, K-6 will maintain at or increase to 1056 by the end of the school year.) Looked at money that was budgeted for that. It was decided that ACE has a grant, so they will not need all of their money, so it can be used in other places if needed. We want the integrated fine arts lesson to be 1056 or higher.
7. Discuss Goal #3: (The percent of students in grades 4-6 performing on grade level or making typical progress in math will improve from 70% to 72% by the end of the school year.) We discussed how we want all students to make a year of growth. We talked about our CMI program, and how we are hoping to see good growth from our math scores this year. The principal is going to look at our percentage for testing last year, and when we meet next, we will make a goal when we have that information.
8. We discussed the need to buy another Chromebook cart for next year because one of the carts is getting old. We will be losing the devices that Imagine Learning lets us use, so we will need to replace those as well.
9. Discuss Goal #4: (Gifted/Talented Program will be implemented and maintained.) We discussed the Gifted and Talented program and how students are identified. We discussed how a program for students who are gifted and talented is important for those students who are . We also talked about how our program is pretty low key, and that we want to keep the program, but not add money to the program at this time. We also decided to keep it as a separate goal instead of making it a part of our arts goal.
