### Discussion of School Improvement Plan

- Goal #1 Reading: The percent of student in grades 1-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress will improve from 70% to 73%.
- Goal #2 Fine Arts: The number of integrated fine arts lessons, K-6, will maintain at, or increase to 1056 by the end of the school year.
- Goal #3 Math: The percent of students in grades 4-6 performing on grade level or making typical progress in math will improve 70% to 72% by the end of the school year.
- Goal #4 Gifted and Talented: Gifted and Talented Program will be implemented and maintained.

## Discussed the Summary of Programs/Activities Not Included in Plan

### Safe Walking Route

Parents calling concerned about the intersection north of the school. Proposal that we provide a stipend for a school employee to be a crossing guard.

### Parent Concern
