



Art City Cold and Inclement Weather Procedures

- We recommend that students arrive at school no earlier than 8:20 for supervision purposes, unless they are eating breakfast. Breakfast service begins at 8:15. The building will be open for students at 8:15. Students can wait for the start of class in the lobby if the temperature is below 32 degrees, otherwise students will go outside until the start of school. The stop light in the lobby will tell students to stay inside or go outside.
- Students should arrive dressed for the weather of the day so that they can safely and comfortably enjoy recesses. In winter months, students are welcome to bring boots to change into for recesses. All healthy children will be expected to go out for recess except in extreme weather conditions (wind chill, rain, snow, etc.)
- If your child cannot participate in recess for health reasons please send a note to this effect. If it is to be a prolonged indoor stay (longer than 3 days) please contact your child's teacher.
- Students will remain inside in extreme weather conditions such as: very cold temperatures (below 20 degrees), including wind chill, heavy rain/snowfall, unhealthy air/inversion conditions (we check air quality daily.)
- Please be considerate and safety conscious as you drop off and pick up students at school. The winter months see an increase in the number of cars. Remember to help with the flow of traffic by using the outside pick up lane for pull through only, keeping the crosswalk area clear, use parking stalls if you need to leave your vehicle or enter the building. Also, please remind your children to use the crosswalk. Safety is a priority.
- In the event of a major weather event Nebo School District will notify parents via email and/or automated phone calls. Information will also be posted and updated on the district web page www.nebo.edu.
- In the event of an emergency, we will notify parents via automated phone calls. Please check your voicemail before calling the school so that we can keep our lines open. Please do not call the school unless it is absolutely necessary. The office staff will need to be free to take care of students and ensure safety. If we need to evacuate the school, we would first go to the church next to the school. All teachers and staff members will remain with their classes to care for the students. Unless otherwise notified, we will release students only to parents or family members who are listed as emergency contacts in Infinite Campus. Please keep this information updated
