

## Art City Discipline Rubrics 2017-18

Art City School uses Stand Strong as a behavior framework. We also use reflection and a ticket system when necessary. The goal is to empower students to improve their behavior and safety. Each form/ticket issued will include, among other things, the student's name, the inappropriate behavior and who reported the behavior. A copy of the ticket will be sent home that day and will need to be signed by a parent and returned to the teacher the following morning before school. Students begin each term with a "clean slate."

### MINOR OFFENSES

- Name calling
  - Teasing
  - Disrespectful attitudes/ behaviors
  - Making fun, mocking
  - Swearing
  - Spreading rumors
  - Inappropriate Notes
- Play fighting, horse-playing, kicking, pushing
  - Throwing snow/ice
  - Any others determined by faculty & administration

### MAJOR OFFENSES

- Vulgar/profane language
  - Fighting
  - Aggressive behavior inappropriate for school
  - Intention to harm/hurt
  - Stealing
  - Sexual offenses
- Safe School Violation (Illegal Activities, Possession of fake or real weapon)
  - Harassment (major)
  - Destroying or damaging property (vandalism)
  - Any others determined by faculty & administration
