The goal is to empower students to improve their behavior and safety, treat others with respect and kindness and stand up for others in a productive and helpful manner. In the event that consequences need to be implemented, the following process will be used.

Serious offenses will result in automatic phone calls home and/or visit with the principal as deemed appropriate by school personnel.
